4. **May be selected from any of these categories:**

  - c. **Honorary [may be any person, who through his/her exceptional loyalty to Southwestern College athletics, has made a vital and lasting contribution.**  
**[This person(s) shall also have exhibited leadership in his/her community and lifestyle.]**
