**Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Tournament Semifinal  
Southwestern College at Kansas Wesleyan University is the "College Fanz NAIA Basketball  
Game of the Week" Saturday, February 27th**

Grand Island, NE – February 25, 2010 – This Saturday afternoon, February 27<sup>th</sup>, the [College Fanz NAIA Basketball Game of the Week](http://www.CollegeFanz.com) features action in the Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference (KCAC) Women's Basketball Tournament, as [Southwestern College](#) plays [Kansas Wesleyan University](#) at Mabee Arena in Salina, Kansas in a semifinal matchup at 2p.m. Central / 3 p.m. Eastern Time, live on <http://www.CollegeFanz.com>.

The Lady Builders of Southwestern College (Winfield, KS) are the #3 seed in the 2010 KCAC Tournament, thanks to their 20-8 overall record this season and their 13-5 mark in the league. Wednesday night in Winfield, Head Coach Dave Denly's squad was victorious in their quarterfinal matchup with #6-seed Tabor College, 67-40. Southwestern was led by junior guard/forward Jasmine Manuel who finished with 14 points and junior forward Sara Maxwell who came off the bench to score 10 points in just 12 minutes.

Meanwhile, host Kansas Wesleyan is the #2 seed in the 2010 KCAC tournament, thanks to a 21-6 overall record and a 15-3 mark in the conference. In the KCAC Tournament quarterfinal on Wednesday night, the Coyotes defeated the #7 seed Ottawa University Braves, 66-58 in Salina. Head Coach Gordon Reimer's squad has been paced by sophomore guard Shelby Babcock with 13.7 points per game, while freshman forward Stephanie Frost has averaged 7.2 rebounds per game. Frost was twice named the KCAC player of the week, including this past week.

The winner of the KCAC Tournament is the first automatic qualifier to the NAIA National Championships in Sioux City, Iowa beginning March 10. The second automatic qualifier from the KCAC is the highest remaining seed in the tournament, regardless of finish in the tournament.
